It is with great pleasure that we invite you to the **The Second Conference on Mathematics and Computer Science Teaching, TEMATCOM 2026** (a national conference with international participation), which will be held on **May 29 and 30** at the **Faculty of Science University of Kragujevac**.

Following the great success of the first **TEMATCOM 2024** conference, which brought together 97 lecturers and featured 61 presentations – exceeding all our expectations – we are delighted to continue the realization of our initial idea of holding this event on a regular basis.

The conference is organized by the **Faculty of Science, University of Kragujevac**, in cooperation with the **Mathematical Society of Serbia – Kragujevac Branch**.

The conference program includes plenary lectures, contributed talks, and poster sessions, organized into two thematic sections.

Research in the Teaching of Mathematics and Computer Science

- Methodology of Teaching Mathematics
- Methodology of Teaching Computer Science and Informatics
- History and Philosophy of Mathematics
- Curriculum Development and Educational Policies

School practise

- Presentation of situations, problems, solutions, and good practices from school experience
- Demonstration and model lessons
- National and international competitions and assessments
- Direct effects of educational reforms

Papers outside the listed thematic areas that fit into the conference theme are also welcome.

The deadline for abstract submission is **April 1, 2026**. Notification of abstract acceptance will be sent to authors by **May 1, 2026**. Full papers should be submitted by **September 1, 2026**.

Selected papers, after the peer-review process, will be published in the **Journal of Educational Studies in Mathematics and Computer Science (JESMAC)**, published by the Faculty of Science, University of Kragujevac.

The official languages of the conference are **Serbian** and **English**.

The registration fee of **50 euros** includes conference materials, a welcome cocktail, and refreshments during breaks. Students at all levels of study and teachers are entitled to a reduced fee of **35 euros**. For participants who wish to attend at the conference dinner, the fee increases by **35 euros**.
